
Title: Archiving History Data


To archive history follow the steps below:

1. Run Database Utility tool.

In case when MPW and SQL Server installed at the same computer just run Database Utility from Millennium program folder.



Note: If you are using Windows7 then run Database Utility as administrator:





In cases where SQL Server installed on a separate computer:


• Copy Database Utility files to the computer where SQL Server installed.

You will need following files:

- MpwDB.exe
- o IpcdII.dll
- MpwSig.dll
- o Mpw.rf
- Mpw.rst
- Run MpwDB.exe
- 2. Go to Database Tools -> Archive History




- 3. Enter operator's login and password
- 4. Select required options for archive



- 5. Click "Begin Archive" when you ready.
- 6. Confirm archive




7. Process will start immediately.



<u>Note:</u> After archiving of the history, History and Alarm records will be available through the special reports "Archived History" and "Archived Alarm--Incident". Usage of these reports is the same as for "History" and "Alarm--Incident" reports. You can create filters to get the required data.
