Title: Migrating from WaPac to Xtra


Overall process of migration is as follows:

- 1. Backup current database and send it to Millennium Technical Support.
- 2. Receive converted backup from support.
- 3. Install Xtra system.
- 4. Restore converted backup in new Xtra system.


Let's take a closer look at these steps.

To perform backup of current database:

1. Run WaPac Manager and go to Tools.




2. Check option Backup and select Backup Location. Click Ok.




3. Send the backup file to technical support. Details of how to transfer file should be provided in email from technical support.


When you received converted backup file you may proceed with Xtra installation. To install Xtra system:

1. Make sure you have installed SQL Server with Full Text Search feature.







3. Select I Agree option if you agree with License Agreement and click Next.




4. Select components to install as shown below and click Next




5. Enter SQL server connection string in field **Sql Server**. Select authentication type. Enter User Name and Password if you choose SQL Server Authentication. Click **Next**.




6. Enter path to installation folder. Click **Next**.




7. Select type of Web Site installation. Click Next.



8. Enter Port Configuration as shown below. Click **Next**. Installation will start immediately.



9. Installation complete. Click **Close**.




10. Now you need to put converted database to the right place. Open folder where Xtra system was installed. By default it is:


On x86 Windows: C:\Program Files\MillenniumGroup\MilleniumXtra

On x64 Windows: C:\Program Files (x86)\MillenniumGroup\MilleniumXtra

- 11. Go to folder **WebSiteComponent\Backup**. Copy converted database from Technical Support here.
- 12. Run internet browser. If you select "Default Web Site" on step 7 then enter http://localhost/ in address bar.



- 13. Login to the system using next credentials: Company millennium, Username admin. Leave password blank.
- 14. Go to System Administration > Database Functions > Restore Database.



- 15. In dropdown list, select the backup from the converted database. Click **Restore**.
- 16. After database has been restored you can log in using logins from your previous system. Password for every user will be 'Pa\$\$word'.
